1.2 relating to insurance; placing restrictions on self-insured small employers; proposing
1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 60A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[60A.237] SMALL EMPLOYER PLAN ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTION.**

1.6 A small employer under section 62L.02, subdivision 26, that provides small employer
1.7 plan coverage to eligible employees through a contract to provide stop-loss coverage and
1.8 not through a policy of accident and sickness is not eligible to enroll in another small
1.9 employer plan providing benefits through a policy of accident and sickness until 36 months
1.10 from the date coverage under the stop-loss plan was no longer in effect.
