1.7	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, in addition to all sources
1.8	of funding described in Minnesota Statutes, section 356.63, paragraphs (a) and (b), any
1.9	public retirement plan described in Minnesota Statutes, section 356.63, paragraph (b), is
1.10	authorized to accept for deposit in its fund the following:
1.11	<u>(1) gifts;</u>
1.12	(2) donations;
1.13	(3) bequests;
1.14	(4) life insurance death benefits, including benefits pursuant to a life insurance
1.15	premium financing or other arrangement covering the lives of retirees and survivors under
1.16	any such pension plan; and
1.17	(5) other similar sources of funding.
