1.8	The commissioner of human services shall implement a Supplemental Nutrition
1.9	Assistance Program (SNAP) restaurant meals program to allow eligible SNAP recipients
1.10	to buy prepared meals at approved electronic benefits transfer (EBT) vendors. The
1.11	commissioner shall ensure that the program meets the requirements of the United States
