- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to health; appropriating money for local public health emergency
- 1.3 preparedness and response capabilities.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; LOCAL AND TRIBAL PUBLIC HEALTH**
- 1.6 **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE.**
- 1.7 (a) \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the
- 1.8 commissioner of health to be distributed to local and Tribal public health organizations for
- 1.9 emergency preparedness and response capabilities. Ninety percent of this appropriation
- 1.10 must be distributed to local and Tribal public health organizations. Ten percent of this
- 1.11 appropriation may be used by the Department of Health for administrative costs.
- 1.12 (b) Use of the appropriation in this section must align with the Centers for Disease
- 1.13 Control and Prevention's issued report: Public Health Emergency Preparedness and Response
- 1.14 Capabilities: National Standards for State, Local, Tribal, and Territorial Public Health.
- 1.15 (c) The base for fiscal year 2024 and each fiscal year thereafter is \$9,000,000.
