1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to human services; modifying the definition of legal nonlicensed child  
1.3 care provider; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 119B.011, subdivision  
1.4 16.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 119B.011, subdivision 16, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 16. **Legal nonlicensed child care provider.** "Legal nonlicensed child care  
1.8 provider" means: (1) a child care provider who is excluded from licensing requirements  
1.9 under section 245A.03, subdivision 2; or (2) a child care provider authorized to provide  
1.10 care in a child's home under section 119B.09, subdivision 13, provided the provider only  
1.11 cares for related children, children from a single, unrelated family, or both related children  
1.12 and children from a single, unrelated family. A legal nonlicensed child care provider may  
1.13 care for up to four children from two unrelated families or both related children and children  
1.14 from two unrelated families, not to exceed four children at any time.
