1.6	Section 1. WARREN; ENERGY EFFICIENT FACILITIES, SOLAR ENERGY
1.7	FIXTURES.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$435,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.10	Warren to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip energy efficient rest rooms, a
1.11	gathering area, and heated storage area, all as part of the city's new community recreation
1.12	facility, and to acquire and install a solar energy system on or adjacent to the city's new
1.13	community recreation facility that will provide energy needed for the facility. This
1.14	appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines
1.15	that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by
1.16	Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
1.17	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
