- 1.1A bill for an act
- 1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for predesign and design of
- 1.3facilities at the Wood Lake Nature Center in Richfield; authorizing the sale and
- 1.4issuance of state bonds.
- 1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6Section 1. **RICHFIELD; WOOD LAKE NATURE CENTER.**
- 1.7Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,800,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.8to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
- 1.9Richfield to predesign and design a new nature center building, and for the renovation of
- 1.10the site and trails at Wood Lake Nature Center. This appropriation does not require a nonstate
- 1.11contribution.
- 1.12Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.13proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.14the state in an amount up to \$1,800,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.15prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.16Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 1.17**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
