1.6	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; MODERNIZING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
1.7	FOR CHILD CARE AND EARLY LEARNING PROGRAMS.
1.8	(a) \$ in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.9	of management and budget to develop and implement a plan to modernize the information
1.10	technology systems that support the child care and early learning programs administered
1.11	by the Departments of Education and Human Services. The commissioner may contract for
1.12	the services contained in this section. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until
1.13	June 30, 2025.
1.14	(b) The plan must support the goal of creating information technology systems for child
1.15	care and early learning programs that collect, analyze, share, and report data on program
1.16	participation, school readiness, early screening, and other childhood indicators. The plan
1.17	must include strategies to:
1.18	(1) increase the efficiency and effectiveness with which child care and early learning
1.19	programs serve children and families;
1.20	(2) improve coordination among child care and early learning programs for families;
