BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2021 Supplement, section 171.188, is amended to read:
171.188 DRIVING WHILE IMPAIRED REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION;
OFF-ROAD RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND MOTORBOATS.
(a) The provisions of this chapter for revoking or canceling a driver's license or
nonresident driving privilege for alcohol, controlled substance, or intoxicating substance
any of the following violations also apply to the operating privileges for off-road recreational
vehicles and motorboats:
(1) alcohol, controlled substance, or intoxicating substance violations;
(2) manslaughter resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle; or
(3) criminal vehicular homicide or injury under section 609.2112, 609.2113, or 609.2114,
or Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 609.21.
(b) Upon conviction for any violation described in paragraph (a), the commissioner must
notify a person that the person is prohibited from operating off-road recreational vehicles
and motorboats for the same period that the person's driver's license or driving privilege is
revoked or canceled for the alcohol, controlled substance, or intoxicating substance
conviction.
