8	of public safety for grants to fire departments for the reimbursement of costs incurred in
9	the purchase of personal protective equipment, including but not limited to fire coats, pants,
10	flak vests, helmets, and boots. The commissioner shall award the grants pursuant to the
11	recommendations of the Fire Service Advisory Committee established under Minnesota
12	Statutes, section 299F.012, subdivision 2. A grant awarded under this section must include
13	a local match based on the population of an applicant fire department's coverage area, as
.14	determined by the commissioner. This is a onetime appropriation.
