- 1.6BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.7Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 245C.10, subdivision 18, is amended to read:
- 1.8Subd. 18. **Applicants, licensees, and other occupations regulated by commissioner**
- 1.9**of health.** The applicant or license holder is responsible for paying to the Department of
- 1.10Human Services all fees associated with the preparation of the fingerprints, the criminal
- 1.11records check consent form, and the criminal background check. The Department of Health
- 1.12and the Department of Human Services shall enter into an interagency agreement to ensure
- 1.13that the Department of Health pays for all fees under this subdivision on behalf of applicants
- 1.14and license holders regulated by the commissioner of health.
- 1.15**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
