1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. [168.1283] ROTARY INTERNATIONAL PLATES.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Issuance of plates. The commissioner shall issue Rotary International
1.7	special license plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:
1.8	(1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
1.9	truck, motorcycle, or recreational motor vehicle;
1.10	(2) pays an additional fee of \$10 for each set of plates;
1.11	(3) pays the registration tax required under section 168.013, along with any other fees
1.12	required by this chapter;
1.13	(4) contributes \$25 upon initial application and a minimum of \$5 annually to the Rotary
1.14	Foundation account; and
1.15	(5) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
1.16	licensing of drivers.
1.17	Subd. 2. Design. The commissioner shall adopt a suitable design for the plate that must
1.18	include the Rotary International symbol and the phrase "Service Above Self."
1.19	Subd. 3. Plates transfer. On application to the commissioner and payment of a transfer
1.20	fee of \$5, special plates may be transferred to another qualified motor vehicle that is
1.21	registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued.
