1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND BORDERING PUBLIC
1.6	WATERS; FREEBORN COUNTY.
1.7	(a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45 and 282.018, subdivision 1,
1.8	Freeborn County may sell the tax-forfeited land bordering public waters that is described
1.9	in paragraph (c).
1.10	(b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The
1.11	attorney general may make necessary changes to the legal description to correct errors
1.12	and ensure accuracy.
1.13	(c) The land to be sold is in Freeborn County and is described as: Parcel ID No.
1.14	25.040.0040 in Section 34, Township 104 North, Range 23 West.
1.15	(d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would be
1.16	best served if the land was returned to private ownership.
