1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 179A.07, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.6Subd. 6. **Time off.** A public employer must afford reasonable time off to elected officers

1.7or appointed representatives of the exclusive representative to conduct the duties of the

1.8exclusive representative and must, upon request, provide for leaves of absence to elected

1.9or appointed officials of the exclusive representative or to a full-time appointed official of

1.10an exclusive representative of teachers in another Minnesota school district. Time off

1.11provided under this subdivision must not be used to engage in any political activities.
