1.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.7	Section 1. APPROPRIATION.
1.8	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$7,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board to predesign, design, engineer,
1.10	construct, and complete preservation and renovation of a facility that provides educational
1.11	and cultural experiences to students, tourists, and Minnesota residents in the city of
1.12	Minneapolis that is open to the public in conjunction with a private nonprofit institution
1.13	located on Minneapolis Park Board land on the site of the old Parade Grounds, subject
1.14	to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695. This appropriation will be matched with up to
