1.5 Section 1. **[256B.758] REIMBURSEMENT FOR DOULA SERVICES.**

1.6 Effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2019, payments for doula services

1.7 provided by a certified doula shall be \$47 per prenatal or postpartum visit, up to a total of

1.8 six visits, and \$488 for attending and providing doula services at a birth.
