## 1.7 **PERSONS WITH PHYSICAL OR SENSORY DISABILITIES PROHIBITED.**

- (a) It is an unfair discriminatory practice for an owner, operator, or manager of a
  hotel, restaurant, public conveyance, or other public place to prohibit a blind or deaf
- 1.10 person or a person with a physical or sensory disability from taking a service animal into
- 1.11 the public place or conveyance if the service animal can be properly identified as being
- 1.12 from a recognized program which trains service animals to aid blind or deaf persons or
- 1.13 persons with physical or sensory disabilities, and if the animal is properly harnessed or
- 1.14 leashed so that the blind or deaf person or a person with a physical or sensory disability
- 1.15 may maintain control of the animal.
- (b) No person shall require a blind, physically disabled, or deaf person to make an
  extra payment or pay an additional charge when taking a service animal into any of the
