- 1.6 Section 1. Laws 2020, Fifth Special Session chapter 3, article 10, section 3, is amended

- 1.8 Sec. 3. **TEMPORARY PERSONAL CARE ASSISTANCE COMPENSATION FOR**
- 1.9 **SERVICES PROVIDED BY A PARENT OR SPOUSE.**
- 1.10 (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0659, subdivisions 3, paragraph
- 1.11 (a), clause (1); 11, paragraph (c); and 19, paragraph (b), clause (3), during a peacetime
- 1.12 emergency declared by the governor under Minnesota Statutes, section 12.31, subdivision
- 1.13 2, for an outbreak of COVID-19, a parent, stepparent, or legal guardian of a minor who is
- 1.14 a personal care assistance recipient or a spouse of a personal care assistance recipient may
- 1.15 provide and be paid for providing personal care assistance services.
- 1.16 (b) This section expires ~~February 7, 2021~~ upon full implementation and phase-in of the
- 1.17 community first services and supports program under Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.85.
- 1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE; REVIVAL AND REENACTMENT.** This section is effective
- 1.19 retroactively from February 6, 2021, or upon federal approval, whichever is later, and Laws
- 1.20 2020, Fifth Special Session chapter 3, article 10, section 3, is revived and reenacted as of
- 1.21 that date. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor of statutes when
- 1.22 federal approval is obtained.
