1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[604A.41] ANIMAL CRUELTY REPORTING.**

1.6 A licensed veterinarian, or a person under the direction of a licensed veterinarian, acting

1.7 in good faith is immune from civil liability for reporting known or suspected inhumane

1.8 treatment of animals, including but not limited to neglect, cruelty, or abuse as defined in

1.9 section 343.20 or 346.36.
