1.1 A bill for an act 1.2 relating to appropriations; appropriating money to the Minnesota Historical 1.3 Society.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION; MINNESOTA HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

\$19,875,000 in fiscal year 2012 and \$16,675,000 in fiscal year 2013 are appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund to the Minnesota Historical Society to preserve and enhance access to Minnesota's history and its cultural and historical resources. Grant agreements entered into by the Minnesota Historical Society and other recipients of appropriations in this section shall ensure that these funds are used to supplement and not substitute for traditional sources of funding. Funds directly appropriated to the Minnesota Historical Society shall be used to supplement, and not substitute for, traditional sources of funding. Funds appropriated in the first year may be carried over to the second year. Funds appropriated in the first year are available until June 30, 2013. Funds appropriated in the second year are available until June 30, 2014. If a project receives federal funds, the time period of the appropriation is extended to equal the availability of the federal funds. For historic preservation projects that improve historic structures, the amounts are available until June 30, 2015. Money appropriated in this section may not be spent on activities unless they are directly related to and necessary for a specific appropriation. The Minnesota Historical Society, with the assistance of recipients funded under this section, shall report on all expenditures made from these funds to the legislature and governor by January 15 of each year. Of the amount appropriated under this section:

(1) \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2012 and \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2013 are for history programs and projects operated or conducted by or through local, county, regional, or
