1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. ST. PAUL; MINNESOTA TELECENTER BUILDING RENOVATION.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$ is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.9	St. Paul to construct and renovate the Minnesota Telecenter Building in downtown St.
1.10	Paul. This appropriation is not available until at least an equal amount is committed to
1.11	the project from nonstate sources.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.13	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.14	bonds of the state in an amount up to \$ in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.15	the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.16	Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
