Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 168.123, is amended to read: 1.6 168.123 VETERANS; SPECIAL PLATES. 1.7 Subdivision 1. General requirements; fees. (a) On payment of a fee of \$10 for each 1.8 set of two plates, or for a single plate in the case of a motorcycle plate, payment of the 1.9 registration tax required by law, and compliance with other applicable laws relating to 1.10 vehicle registration and licensing, as applicable, the commissioner shall issue: 1.11 (1) special veteran's plates to an applicant who: 1.12 (1) served in the active military service in a branch of the armed forces of the United 1.13 States or of a nation or society allied with the United States in conducting a foreign war; 1.14 1.15 (2) was discharged under honorable conditions, or meets the eligibility requirements specified in this section; 1.16 (3) meets the requirements for the specific special plate design; and 1.17 (4) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, recreational motor vehicle, or one-ton 1.18 pickup truck, but which is not a commercial motor vehicle as defined in section 169.011, 1.19

Special motorcycle plates 2.8 issued under this elause section must be the same size as regular motorcycle plates. Plates transfer. (a) On application to the commissioner and payment of a 4.23 transfer fee of \$5, plates issued under subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clause (1), may be 4.24 transferred to another passenger automobile or recreational motor vehicle, or one-ton truck 4.25 described in subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clause (1), if the subsequent vehicle is: 4.26 (1) qualified under subdivision 1 to bear the special plates; and 4.27 (2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued. 4.28 (b) On payment of a fee of \$5, a plate issued under subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clause 4.29 (2), may be transferred to another motorcycle registered to the individual to whom the plate 4.30
