(a) A county may file a policy of no net gain of state 1.8 lands, adopted by the county board, with the commissioner of natural resources. The policy 1.9 must express the county's policy against the acquisition of additional land by the state within 1.10 the county. 1.11 (b) When the commissioner of natural resources acquires private land within a county 1.12 that has filed a policy of no net gain of state lands under this subdivision and the land was 1.13 acquired in fee with money appropriated from the outdoor heritage fund, the commissioner 1.14 of natural resources must sell to a private individual or entity an equal number of acres of 1.15 land within the county. The value of the land sold must be of at least substantially equal 1.16 value of the lands acquired.
