1.8	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 174.12, is amended by adding a
1.9	subdivision to read:
1.10	Subd. 9. Upper St. Anthony Lock and Dam closure grant program. (a) The
1.11	Upper St. Anthony Lock and Dam closure grant program is created to provide economic
1.12	assistance to businesses adversely affected by the closure of the Upper St. Anthony Falls
1.13	Lock and Dam.
1.14	(b) Notwithstanding subdivisions 5, 6, and 7, the commissioner of employment
1.15	and economic development shall:
1.16	(1) accept grant applications from businesses eligible for assistance under paragraph
1.17	(c). Grant applications must be submitted on a form specified by the commissioner;
1.18	(2) review grant applications in the order in which they are received; and
1.19	(3) award grants to eligible applicants within the limits of available appropriations
1.20	and within 60 days after receipt of an application.
1.21	(c) To be eligible for a grant under this section, a business must:
1.22	(1) be located upriver of the Upper St. Anthony Falls Lock and Dam and operate a
1.23	commercial navigation facility; and
1.24	(2) be actively engaged in the use of commercial vessels on the commercially
1.25	navigable waters of the Mississippi River to expedite the movement of commodities.
