1.5	Section 1. SOUTH ST. PAUL; DOUG WOOG ARENA HVAC IMPROVEMENTS.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$350,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7	to the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission for a grant to the city of South St. Paul to
1.8	predesign, design, construct, install, and renovate the heating, ventilating, and air conditioning
1.9	system in Rink 1 of Doug Woog Arena, including a dehumidification system and spectator
1.10	area heating. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and
1.11	budget determines that \$50,000 has been committed from nonstate sources to complete the

1.13	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
