1.9	use its school facilities improvement revenue for:

1.11	(2) facility modifications designed to enhance student and staff safety;
1.12	(3) facilities improvements;
1.13	(4) long-term facilities maintenance; and
1.14	(5) new construction of instructional space, not to exceed in size 20 percent of the square
