A bill for an act
relating to education; establishing the excellence in teaching program;
appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
chapter 122A.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[122A.76] EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING PROGRAM.**

Subdivision 1. **Establishment.** The excellence in teaching program is established to promote the National Board Certification of Teachers throughout the state of Minnesota.

Subd. 2. **Coordinator.** The executive director of the Board of Teaching shall appoint a statewide coordinator for the program under this section. The coordinator's duties shall include, but are not limited to:

(1) promoting understanding of the National Board Certification process throughout the state;

(2) coordinating technical support for National Board Certification candidates;

(3) maintaining an online platform for candidate recruitment and support;

(4) collaborating with education stakeholder groups and organizations; and

(5) partnering with the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards as necessary to implement the purposes of the program.

Subd. 3. **Incentive grants.** The Board of Teaching shall award a onetime incentive grant of \$2,000 to any Minnesota teacher who achieves National Board Certification after June 30, 2015, as long as funds are available. The grants must be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
