- (a) \$...... in fiscal year 2018 and \$..... in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to organizations to support the organizations' parent-to-parent programs for families of children and youth with special health care needs. This is a onetime appropriation.
- (b) Eligible organizations must have an established parent-to-parent program that conducts outreach and support to newly identified parents or guardians of a child or youth with special health care needs; that provides training to educate parents and guardians in ways to support their child and navigate the health, education, and human services systems; that facilitates ongoing peer support for parents and guardians from trained volunteer support parents; and that communicates regularly with other parent-to-parent programs and national organizations to ensure best practices are implemented.
  - (c) Grant recipients must use grant funds for the purposes in paragraph (b).
