A bill for an act
relating to state lands; authorizing public sale of certain tax-forfeited land that
borders public water.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **PUBLIC SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND BORDERING PUBLIC
WATER; GOODHUE COUNTY.**

- (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45 and 282.018, subdivision 1, Goodhue County may sell the tax-forfeited land bordering public water that is described in paragraph (c), under the remaining provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282.
- (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.
- (c) The land to be sold is located in Goodhue County and is described as:
- (1) part of Lot 2, Welch Township, Section 26, Township 113 North, Range 16 West (parcel 46.156.0070); and
- (2) Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, Block 6, Emerald Valley, city of Wannamingo (parcels 70.147.1010, 70.147.1020, 70.147.1030, 70.147.1040, and 70.147.1050).
- (d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would best be served if the lands were returned to private ownership.
