1.6	Subd. 3. Compensatory education revenue. (a) For fiscal year 2014, the compensatory
1.7	education revenue for each building in the district equals the formula allowance minus \$415
1.8	times the compensation revenue pupil units computed according to section 126C.05,
1.9	subdivision 3. For fiscal year 2015 2018 and later, the compensatory education revenue for
1.10	a school district which did not have a pupil unit count that was in the top 20 largest pupil
1.11	unit counts on October 1 of the previous fiscal year for each building in the district equals

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(b) (c) When the district contracting with an alternative program under section 124D.69 changes prior to the start of a school year, the compensatory revenue generated by pupils attending the program shall be paid to the district contracting with the alternative program for the current school year, and shall not be paid to the district contracting with the alternative program for the prior school year.

(e) (d) When the fiscal agent district for an area learning center changes prior to the start of a school year, the compensatory revenue shall be paid to the fiscal agent district for the current school year, and shall not be paid to the fiscal agent district for the prior school year.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for fiscal year 2018 and later.
