A bill for an act
relating to redistricting; adjusting the house of representatives district boundaries
within Senate District 39; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
chapter 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[2.395] THIRTY-NINTH DISTRICT.**

Subdivision 1. Senate district. Senate District 39 consists of that district as
described in the order of the Minnesota Special Redistricting Panel in Hippert v. Ritchie,
No. A11-152 (February 21, 2012).

Subd. 2. House of representatives districts. Notwithstanding the order of the
Minnesota Special Redistricting Panel in Hippert v. Ritchie, No. A11-152 (February
21, 2012), Senate District 39, as described in that order, is divided into two house of
representatives districts as follows:

(a) House of Representatives District 39A consists of that district as described in
file L39A-1, on file with the Geographic Information Systems Office of the Legislative
Coordinating Commission and published on its Web site on March 9, 2012.

(b) House of Representatives District 39B consists of that district as described in
file L39B-1, on file with the Geographic Information Systems Office of the Legislative
Coordinating Commission and published on its Web site on March 9, 2012.

Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Section 1 is effective for the state primary and state general elections conducted
in 2014 for terms of office beginning on the first Monday in January 2015, and for all
elections held thereafter.
