- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to education; requiring the Minnesota State High School League to adopt
- 1.3 policies relating to youth hockey; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section
- 1.4 128C.01, subdivision 3.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 128C.01, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 3. **League power to control.** (a) The State High School League may control
- 1.8 contests by and between pupils of the Minnesota high schools that are delegated to it under
- 1.9 this section.
- 1.10 (b) The league must adopt rules and regulations providing that:
- 1.11 (1) the length of a high school varsity hockey game is three 20-minute periods;
- 1.12 (2) high school varsity hockey teams may participate in up to six exhibition games per
- 1.13 season under the control of the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission, and exhibition
- 1.14 games under this clause shall not count against the maximum per-season game limit otherwise
- 1.15 established by league rule; and
- 1.16 (3) high school junior varsity girls hockey teams may participate in up to six exhibition
- 1.17 games per season against teams not affiliated with a school or under the control of the league.
- 1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
