Section 1. NATIONAL U. S. JUNIOR OLYMPIC AND DISABLED AMERICAN

SKI CENTER.

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$2,100,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

fund to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to the Minneapolis Park and Recreation

Board to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a ski center at Theodore Wirth

1.11

Regional Park in Golden Valley, Hennepin County.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

1.13

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue

1.14

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$2,100,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
