1.7	The Board of Pardons shall consist of the governor, the chief justice of the supreme
1.8	court, and the attorney general. The governor, in conjunction with the board, may grant
1.9	pardons and reprieves and commute the sentence of any person convicted of any offense
1.10	against the laws of the state, in the manner and under the conditions and rules hereinafter
1.11	prescribed, but not otherwise.

1.13	Subdivision 1. Absolute or conditional pardons; commutation of sentences. The
1.14	governor, in conjunction with the Board of Pardons, may grant an absolute or a conditional
1.15	pardon, but every conditional pardon shall state the terms and conditions on which it was
1.16	granted. Every pardon or commutation of sentence shall be in writing and shall have no
1.17	force or effect unless granted by a unanimous vote of the board duly convened if the governor
1.18	or a majority of the board duly convened opposes the pardon or commutation.
