- relating to natural resources; allowing reallocation of prior appropriations toleverage federal funds.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## 1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION REALLOCATION.

- 1.6 Notwithstanding Laws 2013, chapter 137, article 3, section 4, paragraph (o), and
- 1.7 Laws 2015, First Special Session chapter 2, article 3, section 4, paragraph (b), the
- 1.8 Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board may allocate its share of the distribution of fiscal
- 1.9 years 2016 and 2017 funds under Minnesota Statutes, section 85.53, subdivision 3, to the
- 1.10 Minneapolis Chain of Lakes, Mississippi Gorge, Above the Falls, and Central Mississippi
- 1.11 Riverfront Regional Parks in accordance with the most recent priority rankings that the
- 1.12 Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board has submitted to the Metropolitan Council. This
- reallocation of funds is anticipated to result in \$500,000 in federal funds to match extant
- 1.14 parks and trails fund appropriations.
- 1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
