- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 124D.65, subdivision 5, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 5. **School district EL revenue.** (a) A district's English learner programs revenue
- 1.8 equals the product of (1) ~~\$704~~ \$1,400 times (2) the greater of ~~20~~ 25 or the adjusted average
- 1.9 daily membership of eligible English learners enrolled in the district during the current
- 1.10 fiscal year.
- 1.11 (b) A pupil ceases to generate state English learner aid in the school year following the
- 1.12 school year in which the pupil attains the state cutoff score on a commissioner-provided
- 1.13 assessment that measures the pupil's emerging academic English.
- 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue in fiscal year 2020 and later.

- 1.19 (2) English learner revenue under section 124D.65, subdivision 5; plus
- 1.20 (3) ~~\$250~~ \$1,000 times the English learner pupil units under section 126C.05, subdivision
