1.8	AUDITOR.
1.9	(a) All responsibilities, as defined in section 15.039, of the Office of the Inspector General
1.10	under the Department of Human Services are transferred to, vested in, and imposed upon
1.11	the state auditor. Section 15.039 applies to this transfer.
1.12	(b) The state auditor shall establish a division of inspector general, having a director
1.13	appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the state auditor.
1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2020.
1.15	Sec. 2. <u>REVISOR INSTRUCTION.</u>
1.16	The revisor of statutes is instructed to replace all occurrences in law of "Office of the
1.17	Inspector General" with "Division of Inspector General in the Office of the State Auditor"
