OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act

relating to elections; prohibiting major political parties from accepting contributions during the legislative session; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.273, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.273, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
 - Subdivision 1. **Contributions during legislative session.** (a) A candidate for the legislature or for constitutional office, the candidate's principal campaign committee, <u>a</u> political party, or a political committee or party unit established by all or a part of the party organization within a house of the legislature, must not solicit or accept a contribution from a registered lobbyist, political committee, political fund, or an association not registered with the board during a regular session of the legislature.
 - (b) A registered lobbyist, political committee, political fund, or an association not registered with the board must not make a contribution to a candidate for the legislature or for constitutional office, the candidate's principal campaign committee, a political party, or a political committee or party unit established by all or a part of the party organization within a house of the legislature during a regular session of the legislature.
- 1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
