1.11	By July 1, 2014, if necessary, the commissioner shall request an amendment to the
1.12	home and community-based services waivers authorized under Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.13	256B.092 and 256B.49, to establish an exception to the consumer-directed community
1.14	supports budget methodology to provide up to 20 percent more funds for those participants
1.15	who have their 21st birthday and graduate from high school between 2013 to 2015 and
1.16	the effective date of Laws 2015, chapter 71, article 7, section 54, and are authorized for
1.17	more services under consumer-directed community supports prior to graduation than
1.18	the amount they are eligible to receive under the current consumer-directed community
