2.1 (c) a sale in which the buyer has initiated the contact and specifically requested the
2.2 seller to visit the buyer's home for the purpose of repairing or performing maintenance
2.3 upon the buyer's property on that visit. If in the course of such a visit, the seller sells
2.4 the buyer the right to receive additional services or goods other than replacement parts
2.5 necessarily used in performing the maintenance or in making the repairs, the sale of those
2.6 additional goods or services would not fall within this exclusion; or

2.7 (d) a sale in which the buyer has initiated the contact either by oral, telephone, or
2.8 written request (other than on a form provided by the seller), and requested the seller to
2.9 visit the buyer's home for the purpose of negotiating the purchase of the specific good
2.10 or service requested. This exclusion shall only apply where the buyer furnishes the
2.11 seller with a separate dated and signed statement in the buyer's handwriting expressly
2.12 acknowledging and waiving the right to cancel the sale; or

2.13 (e) a sale of insurance, securities, or real property; or a sale by public auction; or

2.14 (f) a sale of a motor vehicle, as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 18, when
2.15 the buyer's agreement or offer to purchase is made at a place other than the buyer's
2.16 place of residence.

2.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
