1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 160.293, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 3. Number of trunk highway intersections or interchanges. (a) Unless
1.8	otherwise provided in paragraph (b), a specific service sign for a rural agricultural or

1.9 tourist-oriented business, place of worship, restaurant, motel, resort, recreational camping

1.10 area, or gasoline service station or other retail motor fuel business is limited to one

1.11 intersection or interchange on the trunk highway system.

1.12 (b) Specific service signs are permitted at two intersections or interchanges on the

1.13 trunk highway system if the place of business is located between trunk highways and

1.14 within 15 miles of each qualifying intersection or interchange. Additional signing may

1.15 be considered when the place of business is located between, or approximately an equal

1.16 distance from, two or more trunk highways.

1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

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
