| 1.7 | who has authority under section 203B.05 to administer absentee voting laws shall designate |
| 1.8 | election judges to deliver absentee ballots in accordance with this section. The county auditor |
| 1.9 | must also designate election judges to perform the duties in this section. A ballot may be |
| 1.10 | delivered only to an eligible voter who is a temporary or permanent resident or patient in a |
| 1.11 | health care facility or hospital located in the municipality in which the voter maintains |
| 1.12 | residence. The ballots shall be delivered by two election judges, each of whom is affiliated |
