BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. BLUE EARTH COUNTY FUNCTIONAL FAMILY THERAPY PILOT 1.5 PROJECT; APPROPRIATION. 1.6 (a) \$465,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner 1.7 of human services for a pilot project administered by Blue Earth County to increase mental 1.8 health support for at-risk youth 11 to 18 years of age in Blue Earth County and Nicollet 1.9 County, in partnership with Mankato area public schools. 1.10 (b) The pilot project must implement functional family therapy at a range of proposed 1.11 sites, including but not limited to homes, juvenile correctional facilities, and public schools 1.12 as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 120A.20, subdivision 1. Functional family therapy 1.13 is a family-based prevention and intervention program for at-risk youth that addresses 1.14 complex behavioral problems through flexible, culturally sensitive clinical practices. The 1.15 pilot project must also fund the addition of three full-time equivalent licensed mental health 1.16 professionals, as defined in section 245.4871, subdivision 27, clauses (3), (5), and (6), as 1.17 Blue Earth County staff members. 1.18 (c) Entities that propose implementing the functional family therapy model under this 1.19 pilot project shall be encouraged to complete a three-phase training and certification process, 1.20
