1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to liquor; authorizing an on-sale license in the city of Eagan.

1.3BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4Section 1. **SPORTS AND EVENT CENTER LICENSE; EAGAN.**

1.5Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, or any other local law or ordinance

1.6to the contrary, the city of Eagan may issue up to three on-sale intoxicating liquor licenses

1.7to the owner of a multiuse sports and event center located on property in the city of Eagan,

1.8legally described as Outlot A, Viking Lakes 3rd Addition, or as may be described hereafter

1.9due to subdivision or replatting, or to any facility operator, concessionaire, catering operator,

1.10or other third-party food and beverage vendor for the center under contract with the owner.

1.11A license issued under this section may be issued for a space that is not compact and

1.12contiguous, provided that the licensed premises shall only be the space described in the

1.13approved license. A license issued under this section authorizes sales on all days of the

1.14week. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this section,

1.15apply to a license issued under this section.

1.16**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the Eagan City Council

1.17and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
