Section 1. EXISTING 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSES.

- (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, by the effective date of this section, the 1.6 governing body of a city or county shall issue to a seasonal resort owner who is currently 1.7 licensed under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the off-sale of 3.2 1.8 1.9 percent malt liquor, a license for the off-sale of malt liquor and a license for the off-sale of 1.10 wine.
- (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, by the effective date of this section, the 1.11 governing body of a city or county shall issue to a seasonal resort owner who is currently 1.12 licensed under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the on-sale of 3.2 1.13 percent malt liquor, a license for the on-sale of malt liquor and a license for the on-sale of 1.14 wine. 1.15
  - (c) All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this section, apply to the issuance of a license under this section.
- (d) For purposes of this section, a "seasonal resort owner" means a person who owns 1.18 and operates a seasonal resort, within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes, section 273.13, 1.19 subdivision 22, paragraph (b). 1.20
