BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER; MENTAL HEALTH ADULT DAY**

1.6

TREATMENT RATE INCREASE.

1.7

The commissioner of human services must increase the reimbursement rate for mental

1.8

health adult day treatment by 50 percent over the reimbursement rate in effect on December

1.9

31, 2022.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2023, or 60 days following

federal approval, whichever is later.

Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; MENTAL HEALTH ADULT DAY TREATMENT.**

(a) \$..... in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the state fiscal recovery federal fund

1.14

to the commissioner of human services for a grant to mental health adult day treatment

1.15

providers.

(b) For the purposes of this act, "state fiscal recovery federal fund" means funds received

1.17

by the state from the state fiscal recovery fund in the American Rescue Plan Act, Public

1.18

Law 117-2. This is a onetime appropriation and must be used to maintain mental health

1.19

adult day treatment services until a rate increase begins on January 1, 2023, or upon federal

1.20

approval, whichever is later.
