1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing various local on-sale intoxicating liquor licenses.
 1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS; SPECIAL LICENSE.

1.5 The city of Minneapolis may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to a business
 1.6 located at 3753 Nicollet Avenue South, notwithstanding any law, local ordinance, or charter
 1.7 provision.

1.8 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon approval by the Minneapolis City
 1.9 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.

1.10 Sec. 2. CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS; SPECIAL LICENSE.

1.11 The city of Minneapolis may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to a restaurant
 1.12 located at 4959 Penn Avenue South, notwithstanding any law, local ordinance, or charter
 1.13 provision.

1.14 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon approval by the Minneapolis City
 1.15 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.

1.16 Sec. 3. CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS; SPECIAL LICENSE.

1.17 The city of Minneapolis may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to a restaurant
 1.18 located at 5400 Penn Avenue South, notwithstanding any law or local ordinance or charter
 1.19 provision.

2.1 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the Minneapolis City
2.2 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.

2.3 Sec. 4. **OFF-SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE; HUBBARD COUNTY.**

2.4 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.405, subdivision 2, paragraph (e),
2.5 the Hubbard County Board may issue an off-sale intoxicating liquor license to an exclusive
2.6 liquor store located in Akeley Township. All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter
2.7 340A, not inconsistent with this section, apply to the license authorized under this section.

2.8 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the Hubbard County
2.9 Board and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.

2.10 Sec. 5. **SPECIAL LICENSE; CITY OF NORTH MANKATO.**

2.11 The city of North Mankato may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license, an on-sale
2.12 wine license, or an on-sale malt liquor license for the city-owned facilities known as or
2.13 operated by the Caswell Regional Sporting Complex, notwithstanding any law, local
2.14 ordinance, or charter provision. A license issued under this section authorizes sales on all
2.15 days of the week to persons attending events at the Caswell Regional Sporting Complex.
2.16 The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this section,
2.17 apply to the licenses issued under this section. The city of North Mankato is deemed the
2.18 licensee under this section, and the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, sections 340A.603
2.19 and 340A.604, apply to the licenses as if the facilities were a municipal liquor store.

2.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the North Mankato
2.21 City Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
