BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER; FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES PROVIDERS.

Beginning on the effective date of this section, the commissioner of human services shall accept on a rolling basis proposals submitted in response to "Request for Proposals for Qualified Grantees to Provide Vendor Fiscal/Employer Agent Financial Management Services," published on May 2, 2016. Responders must comply with all proposal instructions and requirements as set forth in the request for proposals, except the submission deadlines. The commissioner shall evaluate all responsive proposals submitted under this section regardless of the date on which the proposal is submitted. The commissioner shall conduct phase I and phase II evaluations using the same procedures and evaluation standards set forth in the request for proposals. The commissioner shall contact responders who submit substantially complete proposals to provide further or missing information or to clarify the responder's proposal. The commissioner shall select all responders that successfully move on to phase III evaluation. For all proposals that move on to phase III evaluation, the commissioner shall not exercise the commissioner's right to reject any or all proposals. The commissioner shall not compare proposals that successfully move on to phase III evaluation. The commissioner shall not reject a proposal that successfully moved on to phase III evaluation after determining that another proposal is more advantageous to the state. This
