	Section 1. UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA; SYSTEMWIDE ACADEMIC AND
-	STUDENT EXPERIENCE INVESTMENTS.
	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$10,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1	fund to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to modernize existing teaching,
10	earning, and research spaces on the University of Minnesota's Crookston, Duluth, and
N	Morris campuses. This appropriation includes funds to predesign, design, construct, furnish,
2	and equip the renovation of teaching, learning, and research spaces including the following
1	ocations: Dowell Hall, Sahlstrom Hall, and Owen Hall on the Crookston campus; AB
ŀ	Anderson Hall on the Duluth campus; and the Humanities Building and Blakely Hall on
t	he Morris campus. The appropriation in this subdivision is intended to cover approximately
1	two-thirds of the cost of the project. The remaining costs must be paid from university
5	sources.
	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
]	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1	the state in an amount up to \$10,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
