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amending Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 4.076, subdivision 3.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

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Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 4.076, subdivision 3, is amended

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to read:

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Subd. 3. **Membership; chair.** (a) The advisory council consists of the following

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members:

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(1) the chair, which is filled on a two-year rotating basis by a designee from:

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(i) the Office of Traffic Safety in the Department of Public Safety;

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(ii) the Office of Traffic Engineering in the Department of Transportation; and

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(iii) the Injury and Violence Prevention Section in the Department of Health;

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(2) two vice chairs, which must be filled by the two designees who are not currently

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serving as chair of the advisory council under clause (1);

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(3) the statewide Toward Zero Deaths coordinator;

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(4) a regional coordinator from the Toward Zero Deaths program;

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(5) the chief of the State Patrol or a designee;

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(6) the state traffic safety engineer in the Department of Transportation or a designee;

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(7) a law enforcement liaison from the Department of Public Safety;

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(8) a representative from the Department of Human Services;

- 2.2 (10) a representative from the Council on Disability;
- 2.3 (11) a representative for Tribal governments;
- 2.4 (12) a representative from the Center for Transportation Studies at the University of

- 2.18 (25) two individuals representing vulnerable road users, including pedestrians, bicyclists,
